

How to register to use our “Ask My GP” online service if you are a carer





We may email you concerning your personal requests. We may process your personal data, which may be shared in anonymised form for research purposes. We do not email patients for marketing purposes or pass your personal details to third parties.

Your password will need to be at least 8 characters long, and can't be things like "password", "12345678" or "abcdefgh". The most important thing is not to use short passwords (we suggest more than 8 characters). Spaces are allowed, so you can use a long phrase of three or four random words. A shorter password with a mix of character types will also work unless it is a very common pattern.

Once the above form has been completed, you will now be able to use the Ask My GP system.






You will need to select "Add another patient"
